

Best practice -1

Title- Establishment of Learner Support Centre (JGNDUPSOU)

Objective-

The key objective of LSC is to provide easy access to education to different sections of society especially to those with seemingly geographical isolation and difficulty and to implement the ODL concept of NEP 2020.

Context-

It will offer a route into higher education for anyone with a desire to learn. Online education offers learners the facility to learn on their own pace and comfort.

Practice-

LSC offers four certificate/diploma courses and three degree courses. During first cycle 106 were admitted for online learning. Majority of students are from working background. There is no age limit to get admission in LSC.

Evidence-

106 students were admitted during first cycle and this number increased to 183 during the second cycle. Approximately 10% students are foreign citizens who get admission in our LSC for higher studies.

Problems encounter-

Main problem encountered during the implementation is that majority of students belongs to different working classes so it becomes difficult to make them available at a particular time during exams. It becomes difficult to provide them tentative date of examination in advance.

Best Practice-2

Title- Hosting of two days district level youth festival

Objectives- The key objective to host this festival was to provide a platform to all schools and colleges having NSS units where they can get together under one roof to enhance the talent of students.

Context- Participation in such festivals opens up a wide era of competition for students where they can grow holistically and show their talent in front of a large audience. It provides them an opportunity to flourish.

Practice- Guru Gobind Singh College Sanghera hosted two days district level youth festival in collaboration with district administration on 24th and 25th November 2023.
